


On shelves with smooth surfaces, the Cante holder can be mounted using only the double-coated adhesive tape. For shelves with rough surfaces, we recommend using both the double-coated tape and the #6x1/2" flathead wood screws to secure your Candp.

When using the adhesive tape, remove the individual tape strips from the bottom liner and place these strips within the channels on the backside of the **Canup**: as indicated.

When using only tape Note: to mount your CandP.s, make sure your mounting surface is free of any dirt or grease by wiping it clean with rubbing alcohol. Do not use common household cleaners as they contain oils which may affect the tape adhesion. For maximum strength, allow the CanUP to bond to the mounted surface for twenty four hours before use.

Once the strips are in place on the canup, remove the top liners and you are ready to mount the Canup. holders to a properly prepared surface.

If your pantry has 12" shelves, you can mount the CanUP, with the open end facing you as indicated.

If your pantry has either 8" or 10" shelves, simply rotate the Cande so that the open end is facing away from you.

Remember, with the Canup holders exclusive patented two-way action, you can mount either way and still be able to slide-in and slide-out™ or snap-in and snap-out™!



Your Can't holder can also be mounted on top of the bottom shelf to act as a load-stabilizer within your motorhome, camper, trailer and boat! During storage, if you expect the inside temperature of your RV or Boat to rise above 140°F, we recommend that you mount your CanUP holders with both the double-coated tape and the #6x1/2" woodscrews.
