## INSTRUCTIONS

Bunk Ladder 60" and 66" (BL200-07 and BL200-08)

### PARTS ENCLOSED:


- 1. One (1) Bunk Ladder 60" or 66"
- 2. Four (4) screws, #10 x 1" Phillips pan head
- 3. One (1) Template for the location of the Bunk Ladder Retainers
- 4. Two (2) Bunk Ladder Retainers

# TOOLS REQUIRED:

- 1. One (1) Phillips Screwdriver
- 2. One (1) Center Punch

#### IMPORTANT!


Your Bunk Ladder must be installed so that the ladder angle is 12° from a vertical position. It should be installed so the distance of the ladder legs, resting on the floor, from the bunk rail are as follows:





## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Tape the Template to the desired location.
- 2. Center punch hole locations.
- 3. Remove the template.
- 4. Screw the Bunk Ladder Retainers horizontally on the center-punched locations.
- 5. Mount the Bunk Ladder into the Bunk Ladder Retainers (see illustration below). CAUTION: Never use the Bunk Ladder unless it is hooked into the Bunk Ladder Retainers installed according to these instructions. To do so could be dangerous!
  - a. Hold the Bunk Ladder parallel to the floor with the Docking Pieces next to the Retainers.



b. Slide the Docking Pieces over the Retainers. Make sure both Docking Pieces (both rails) are engaged.



c. Lower feet of the Bunk Ladder to the floor.



6. Remove the Bunk Ladder from the Retainers only by raising the Bunk Ladder legs to a position parallel to the floor and pulling the Docking Pieces back from the Retainers. To do otherwise will cause damage and invalidate the Manufacturer's Limited Warranty.
